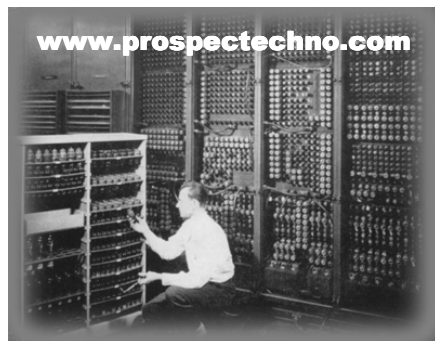

Margaret Rice's Irish Soda Bread

- 4 cups flour ~ 3/4 cups sugar ~ Mix until crumbly ~ 1 stick butter
- Pour boiling water over 2 cups of raisins to plump, drain...
- 1 tsp. salt
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 1 tsp cream of tartar
- 1 egg, beaten
- 1 1/3 cups buttermilk



Add remaining dry ingredients, buttermilk and egg to flour mixture. Add raisins Mix into a sticky ball. Use flour on the counter to knead the dough into a round and place into a buttered 9" cast iron or baking pan. Put a cross on the top, with a knife and bake @375 for hour. Serve with butter and toasts great too!
